



“BACKYARD BOWLS WERE THE NEW TREE FORT

happy to tell you what i know.  the fit wide top plate and the grade stakes, four inch (10cm) wide transition plates and a stick marked at the concrete's thickness and the compacted gravel depths will help you dig the hole.  in addition to the unique template, i made a couple of diagrams: one was to try and figure out how many templates to cut to make the top plate. it also shows the radius used for each part of the shape. the other was me trying to figure out how to shape the walls. how far off a vertical line is the wall as you dig a fort (so on sunny this is marked as inches) deeper? i wanted to make the hole as close to the final as possible to avoid needing extra concrete. it's not really possible to put dirt back if you dig too much away. in the end i used a larger radius for very shallow end (5ft) than i show in the diagram but it's close.  since the deep end is 5.5m across, and is 1.8m, the flat is about 1.8m across in the deep - about $1/3$ of the bowl is 4.26m across  so flat is about 1.26m.  1.8m radius template to adjust that during  i like to do full rotation -

we began our journey

base in two months. i
then, we piled it
